## Directions to Malbone Estate

From East Bay Follow West Main Road to Admiral Kalbfus Road (road that Newport Grand Jai Alai is on).

Take a right onto Admiral Kalbfus Road. Travel approximately ¼ mile and turn left onto Malbone Road.

The entrance to Malbone Estate is across from 97 Malbone Road.

From West Bay Cross the Newport Bridge and follow the road to the end (you will be in front of Newport Grand Jai Alai).

Turn left and proceed up Admiral Kalbfus Road, approximately 500 feet, until you reach Malbone Road.

Turn right onto Malbone Road. The entrance to Malbone Estate is across from 97 Malbone Road.
